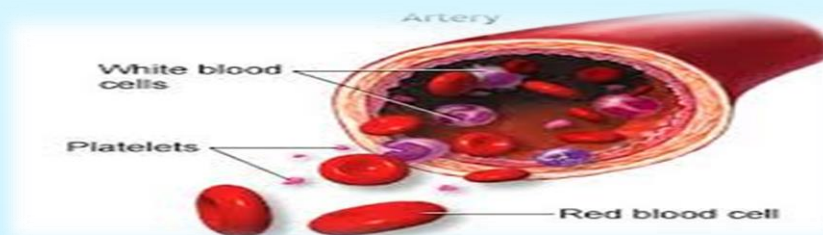

Part D: Reading (4points)

A: Read the following text and choose the best choice.

More than half of blood is plasma. This is a clear, yellow liquid, which carries all the blood cells and platelets and chemicals such as hormones and glucose. Red blood cells carry oxygen around the body, and collect carbon dioxide and take it back to the lungs where it can be sent out. There are millions of red blood cells in one small drop of blood. These cells are red because they have a red-colored chemical called hemoglobin. Red blood cells live for about 4 months, then they are broken up and used to make new blood cells.



White blood cells defend the body against microbes. There are normally around 5,000 to 7,000 white cells in a milliliter of blood, but the number of white cells goes up a lot when you get sick. The white blood cells work with special proteins called antibodies.

Polar Bears

Most people have only seen polar bears in a zoo. Polar bears live in the north, around the area of the Arctic Ocean. They live near the shoreline of the Arctic Ocean; polar bears are found in Greenland, Norway, Alaska northern Russia and northern Canada. They live on the sea ice around the edges of the Arctic Ocean where the water is not too deep and where many seals and other marine animals live. Polar bears are very large animals. Adult males can weigh up to 700 kg. Polar bears have two layers of fur and a thick layer of fat to help keep their body warm. Their favorite food is seal but they will sometimes eat beluga whales, narwhals or walrus. They catch seals by standing on the ice and waiting for the seals to come to the surface to breathe.
